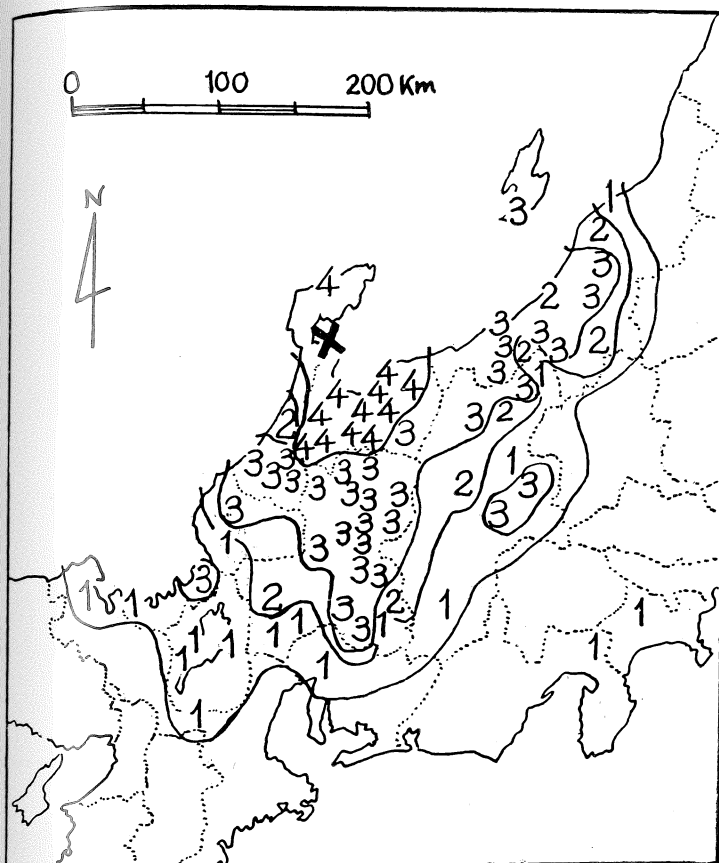


11. The Noto Earthquake, 1933

Wagura and Tazuhama in Kashima District, Ishikawa Pref. were damaged considerably. Several houses, tomb-stones fell down and ware-houses (dozō) and cracks in the ground and landships of small scale occurred at several places.
