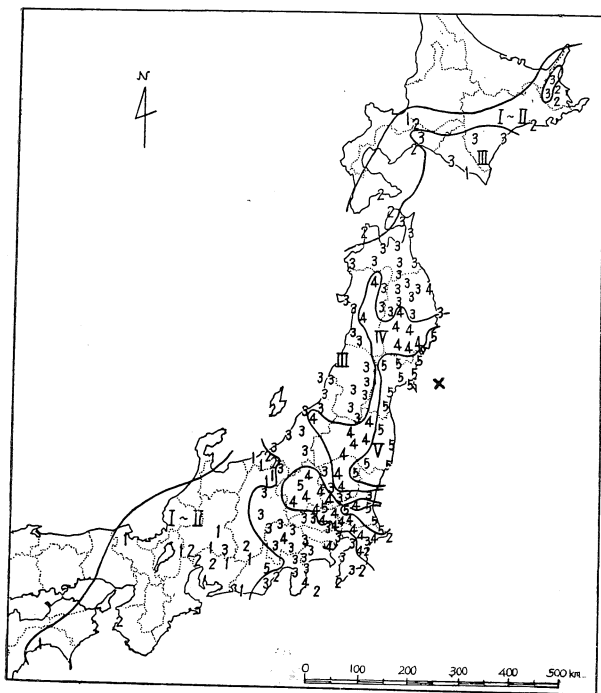


16. The Off Kinkazan Earthquake, 1936

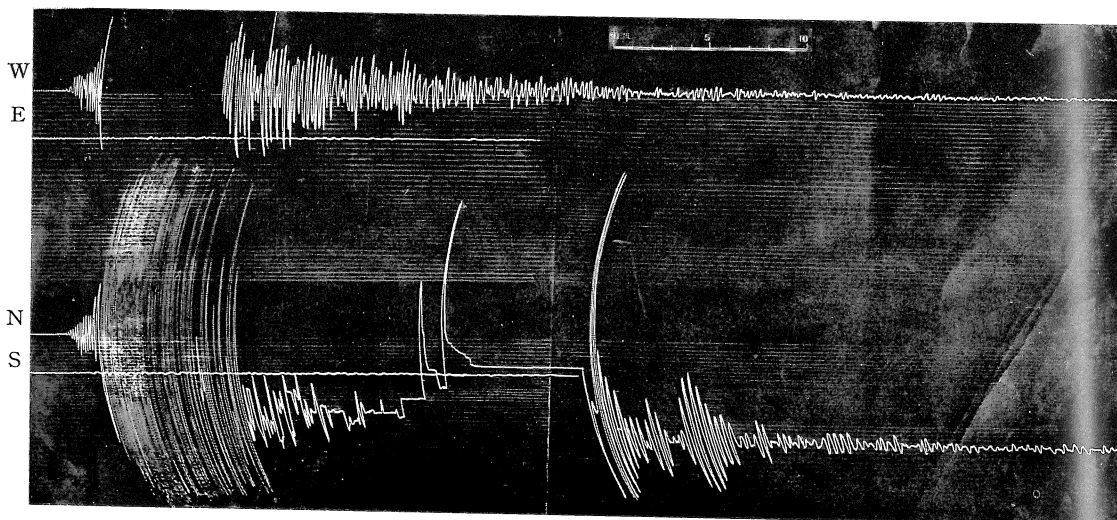
(November 3rd, 05:46. $38^{\circ}24'N$,
 $142^{\circ}00'E$, $r=613$ km, $M=7.8$)



In spite of the large magnitude, it brought little damage to land such that, in parts of Miyagi and Fukushima Prefectures, roof tiles were thrown down, walls of ware-houses (Dozō) fell off and roads cracked. There were 4 injured, 3 huts destroyed, 35 roads destroyed by 450 m in total extension in Miyagi Prefecture.
